

Does your organization consider joining the Population and Sustainable Development Alliance (PSDA)?

Here is what you need to know to make up your mind.

What is the PSDA

The PSDA is an international network of civil society organisations (CSO) and regional inter-governmental organisations (RIGO) from the global north and south. Together we advocate for integrating issues of high and rapid population growth and advances in sexual and reproductive health and rights (SRHR), gender equality, climate change resilience and environmental protection.

We showcase pragmatic, multisectoral and rights-based approaches to sustainable development being implemented by PSDA members. And we engage in joint advocacy work, information sharing and strategic outreach particularly around key regional and global negotiations and events including the UNFCCC's Conferences of the Parties (COPs).

Biggest achievements:

- High-level sensitization and awareness of the value addition of integrating population, SRHR/FP into climate change and environmental sustainability fora
- Integration of family planning and SRH in National Adaptation Plans
- Joint collaboration and resource mobilization between PSDA members and WWF country entities

What do you get out of joining the PSDA:

- 1) A network of CSO and RIGO actors working across the world on the same agenda
- 2) Joint advocacy efforts at strategically relevant events such as COP, UNEA, HLPF
- 3) Learn from like-minded organisations and share your knowledge with others

What does a membership entail?

All members need to join and actively engage in one of the work streams under the PSDA:

- **Global level advocacy** (joint activities incl. side events, messages, analyses etc.)
- **National/regional level advocacy** (incl. NAPs, NDCs, applications for climate funds)
- **Programmatic work** (project development and implementation on the ground)
- **Evidence generation and research** conducted by PSDA members or others
- **Communications, fundraising and alliance strengthening** are cross-cutting issues
